CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE

Where the Customer requires a Consignment to be collected from its premises or those of its own customer or agent (the “premises”) the Customer shall ensure that the arrangements for loading, and unloading are safe and secure so as not to cause any damage or loss of whatever nature to FLX vehicles or to the Consignment or those of its nominated sub-contractors. The Customer will provide adequate security for the vehicle, its contents and equipment and the Consignment whilst on the premises.

FLEET OPTIONS

FLX benefits from the backing of a sustainable multi model fleet of over 400 vehicles providing national and European coverage.

RISK & LOSS

Whilst on the Customer's premises the Customer shall bear the risk of all direct, indirect, financial or consequential loss, damage or deprivation of use of the vehicle or its contents save where this is as the direct result of the negligence of FLX. If the vehicle is lost, stolen or otherwise disappears from the premises, or if the trailer is damaged on the Customer's premises to such an extent that it cannot, in the opinion of FLX or its insurers, be economically restored to a good operating order, condition and appearance, the Customer shall promptly pay FLX an amount equal to the replacement value of the vehicle determined as of the date first missing or damaged.

The Customer will ensure the vehicle on a market value basis to the amount of the loss to FLX and to a minimum value as specified by FLX. If the vehicle is damaged or stolen or is otherwise unroadworthy, until the Customer or the Customer's insurance company has paid FLX in full, the Customer will be responsible for payment of the amount of FLX's daily rate for the vehicle.

By requesting FLX to engage in works on the Customer's behalf the Customer will be deemed to have accepted the FLX conditions of carriage unless communicated in writing to the contrary prior to works being carried out.

STORAGE

FLX operate a BRC Accredited Warehouse capable of storing multiple AMBIENT and temperature products at any time. We offer a full value-added service to all our customers should they require.



LIABILITY FOR LOST PALLETS

FLX liability shall be excluded for any claim that is in respect of cases, boxes or units of whatever nature which individually or in combination constitute only part of a pallet.

In the case of whole pallet liability and/or accountability such liability and/or accountability will be determined subject to the RHA Conditions of Carriage and these Additional Conditions of Carriage. Without prejudice to the RHA Conditions of Carriage FLX will not be liable in circumstances where it is able to produce: -

1. A Load Plan,
2. CCTV Records and
3. Telematics - to prove vehicle location and delivery

Which show the relevant pallet or pallets loaded intact on FLX vehicles.

FLX FUEL SURCHARGE MECHANISM

The base price for fuel is noted on your quotation. The rates are subject to a weekly variable surcharge that would be applied to all delivery charges where fuel represents 32% of total delivery costs (unless otherwise stated).

Please note there is no rebate on fuel below the base price.

ROAD FUEL SURCHARGE FORMULA

Fuel is a volatile commodity and as such we need to apply a fuel surcharge mechanism that recognises increases in price.

There are two key components that form the fuel surcharge calculation, they are:

- Fuel base price – that price which is used at the time the prices were calculated
- Percentage of operating cost that fuel represents

The fuel price is taken from the actual buy price and subject to weekly change.

$$\text{(Pallet rate x } \frac{100 - \text{fuel as \% cost}}{100} \text{)} + \text{((Pallet rate x fuel as \% cost) x } \frac{\text{Actual derv price}}{\text{£1.10}} \text{)}$$

ROAD FUEL SURCHARGE EXAMPLE


In this example the:

- Fuel base is £ 1.10
- The percentage of operating cost is 32%

So, using an example whereby diesel has increased to £1.152 per litre, the fuel surcharge is as follows:

- **£1.152 - £1.100 = £0.052 (£ price variance from base price)**
- **This represents a 4.7272% increase in derv price (£0.052 / £1.100)**
- **Fuel surcharge therefore applicable using example above = 32.0% x 4.7272% = 1.504%**

Therefore, a pallet rate of £25.00 applying the above surcharge of 1.504% would result in a fuel surcharge inclusive price of £25.38 (£25 + (£25 x 1.504%))



FLX FERRY FUEL SURCHARGE MECHANISM

EUROPEAN FERRY CROSSING

For those journey that include a European ferry crossing there is an additional surcharge called SECA/BAF/CAF.

This rate is imposed by the ferry / rail companies and changes monthly.

FERRY SURCHARGE FORMULA

Chargeable load space is calculated using equivalent GKN pallet (standard 1200*1000) spaces as below;

Unit Type	Units On Full Load	Equiv. GKN Space
PV / Chep Pallet	26	1.0000
EURO Pallet	33	0.7878
Auction Trolley (AT)	22	1.1818
Danish Trolley (DT)	43	0.6047

The ferry surcharge is based on the prevailing calendar monthly rates published by our premier ferry services trading partner.

The total ferry surcharge is calculated by applying the number of equivalent pallet spaces used against the monthly ferry surcharge rate.

(Total equivalent pallet spaces used x Ferry surcharge rate)

Example

A load contains 2 Chep pallets & 5 AT's.

Calculation: $((2 \times 1) + (5 \times 1.1818)) = 7.909$ Chep pallet spaces used

Rebate applicable: 7.909 Chep pallet spaces x $\pounds 6.21 = \pounds 49.11$

NB: All prices quoted are net of VAT

ETS - EU Emissions Trading System (ETS) [\(MARITIME TRANSPORTATION\)](#)

From the 1st January 2024 those journey that require ferry crossing there is an additional surcharge called ETS. This rate is imposed by the ferry companies and changes monthly.

This effects all maritime crossing which are either EU to EU, UK to EU or EU to UK. UK to UK is not affected by ETS (for example UK to Northern Ireland).

PALLET MANAGEMENT

Blue CHEP & LLP pallets are treated as within their own Manage Recovery schemes. All other pallets are treated as one-way trips.

ORDER LAYOFF

We operate a web ordering system. This is a simple, robust and secure way of entering orders. Access to the order form will be via the FLX webpage www.flxlogistics.co.uk . Login details will be provided once registered.

PALLET LABELS

Our credit terms are a strict 30 days from invoice date.

Payment is in £ (Sterling) and is subject to VAT at the prevailing rate (20%) (unless otherwise stated).

DURATION AND NOTICE

The agreement shall commence on the Commencement Date and shall continue for a fixed term of 12 months and shall continue thereafter unless it is terminated by either party giving to the other not less than three months 'notice.

On the anniversary of the commencement of service a review of the rates will take place unless any detail surrounding the original quote changes, for example volume.

In the event of the Supplier's repeated or material breach of any of its obligations under the agreement, or in the event of a change in the ownership or control of the Supplier, or if the Supplier at any time for any reason is either prevented from or unable to perform its obligations under this agreement, or if the Supplier makes or offers to make any arrangement with its creditors, or becomes insolvent, or has a receiver/administrator appointed to its business, or is compulsorily or voluntarily wound up, FreshLinc shall be entitled at its discretion, and without prejudice to any other remedy, to suspend the performance of or to terminate the Contract, and in the event of termination to keep or take possession of any goods or of any items belonging to the Supplier and to enter any premises of the Supplier for that purpose or removal of FreshLinc controlled assets.

The above rights of termination of the Contract are without prejudice to any other rights of termination available to FreshLinc or the Supplier under the Contract or the law.

RETURNS AND OTHER CHARGES

Any returns or other applicable charges outside of this quotation will only be applied after consultation with and agreement.
